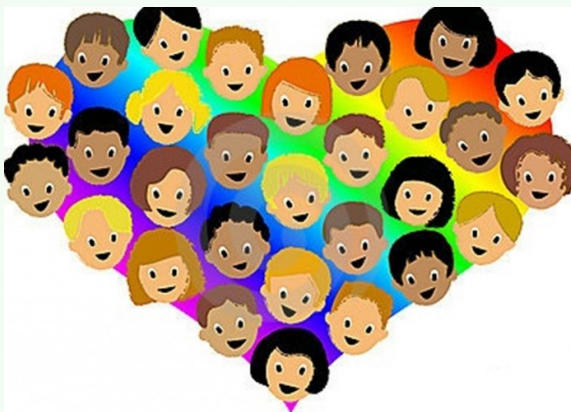


Parking
